Welcome to the Green Quarter!

As the company who designed and installed the TV and Satellite TV network in your building, we would like to draw your attention to the following information.

The system has been built to provide you with the facility to receive analogue and digital TV (BBC1, BBC2, ITV, Channel 4 and 5 as well as Free view, Digital Radio (DAB) and FM radio. In addition, you can also receive digital satellite (SKY) either a standard Sky Digibox, Sky+ or a Sky HD receiver. We have tested all points in your apartment to ensure that you receive the correct level of signal to provide trouble-free viewing. You may need to re-tune your TV to the Winter Hill transmitter if you have moved from another area! For your information, channels are located as follows; BBC1 (Ch. 55), BBC2 (Ch. 62), ITV1 (Ch. 59) Channel 4 (Ch. 65) Channel 5 (Ch. 48).

We can provide Sky systems and install them for you, either standard **Sky Digital**, **Sky+**, or **Sky HD**. We can also arrange the upgrade for you if you are already a Sky subscriber. For the latest information and costs, please send an e-mail to the above address. In the past, we have found that many of the engineers that Sky use, are not keen to install to communal systems and sometimes even unable to install the system properly for you. Also, dealing with Sky direct can be a nightmare in itself.

Enclosed in this pack, is the necessary cable to allow for the distribution of the UHF TV signals to the other points within your apartment if required. On the reverse of this letter is a simple diagram showing how you should connect this cable. The system will also allow you to distribute either video, or if you have it, satellite TV to other rooms in your apartment. If you are just connecting the TV in your living room and don't want a TV in any other room, then just connect the TV to the socket marked "TV" as normal (you may need to use the adapter enclosed). If you have Sky or are having it installed, you should get the engineer to connect the "RF 2" outlet on the back of the Sky receiver to the socket marked "Return" on the wall plate (they won't do this unless you ask them too!). This will allow you to view and operate Sky in the bedroom.

Should you have any problems, you can **contact us either by 'phone, fax or e-mail**.

If you have not received your pack from us, it's most likely to be with the developer or your Landlord.

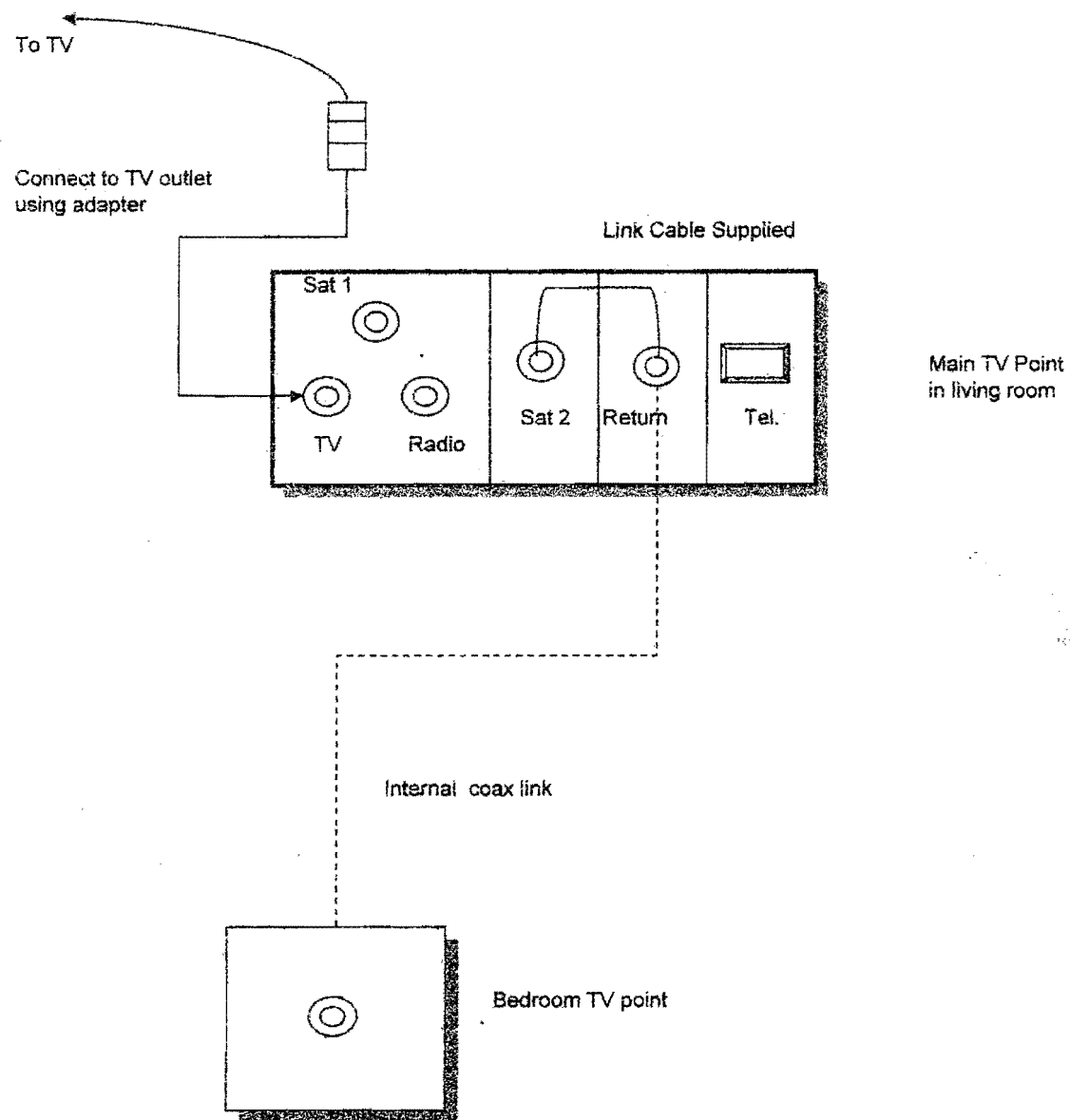
